The Lowry – Health and Safety Policy Statement

In compliance with the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 the Directors recognise that they have a responsibility to ensure all reasonable precautions are taken to provide and maintain safe and healthy working conditions, equipment and safety systems of work for all employees, volunteers, visitors, contractors and the general public and to comply with all statutory requirements and codes of practice.

The Company will, so far as is reasonably practicable, ensure:

1. the provision and maintenance of plant and systems of work that are safe and without risk to health.
2. arrangements for safety and absence of risk in connection with the use, handling, storage and transport of articles and substances
3. the provision of information, instructions, training and supervision as is necessary to enable employees and volunteers to carry out their duties in a manner which prevents harm to themselves or others
4. the maintenance of any place of work under the its control in a condition that is safe and without risk to health
5. the provision of a safe means of access and egress from the place of work
6. the provision and maintenance of a working environment that is safe, without risks to health, and that provides adequate facilities and arrangements for welfare at work
7. the establishment of communication networks with employees to consult on health and safety matters.

Under the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 employees equally have a legal duty to exercise personal responsibility to ensure the health and safety of themselves and of others who may be affected by their acts or omissions at work and also to co-operate so far as necessary to enable the Company to comply with any relevant statutory requirements and our commitment to providing a safe and healthy working environment.
