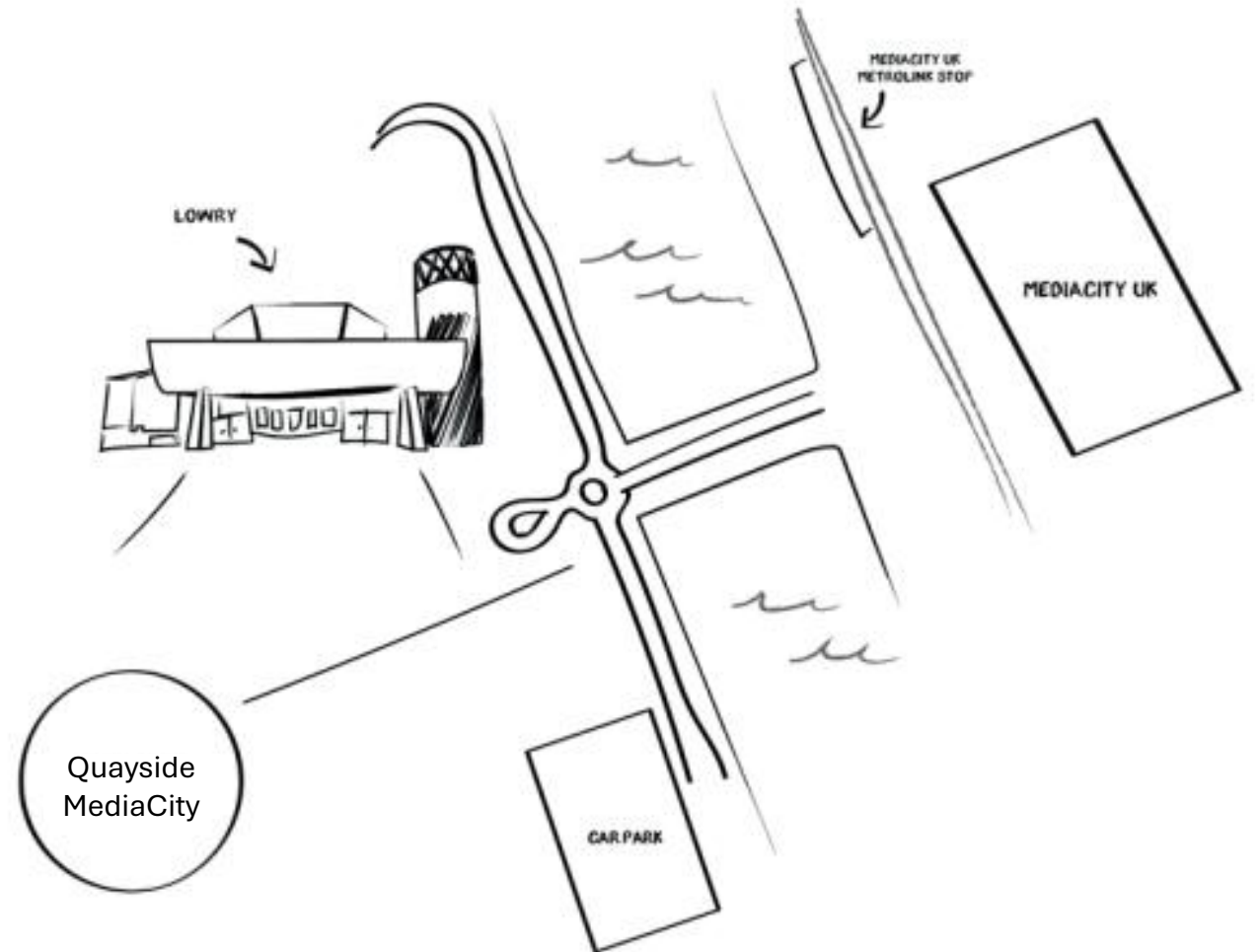

Finding Lowry

Lowry is located on the Salford Quays and can be found on Pier 8 right next to the river.

It can be quite cold and windy outside, but it will be warm inside the building



Finding Lowry

Lowry is a large, metal and glass building made of lots of different shapes.

The entrance is located in a big square opposite the Quayside shopping centre.



When you arrive

Lowry has one main entrance that is at street level with step-free access. This floor is a largely level surface with tactile paving.

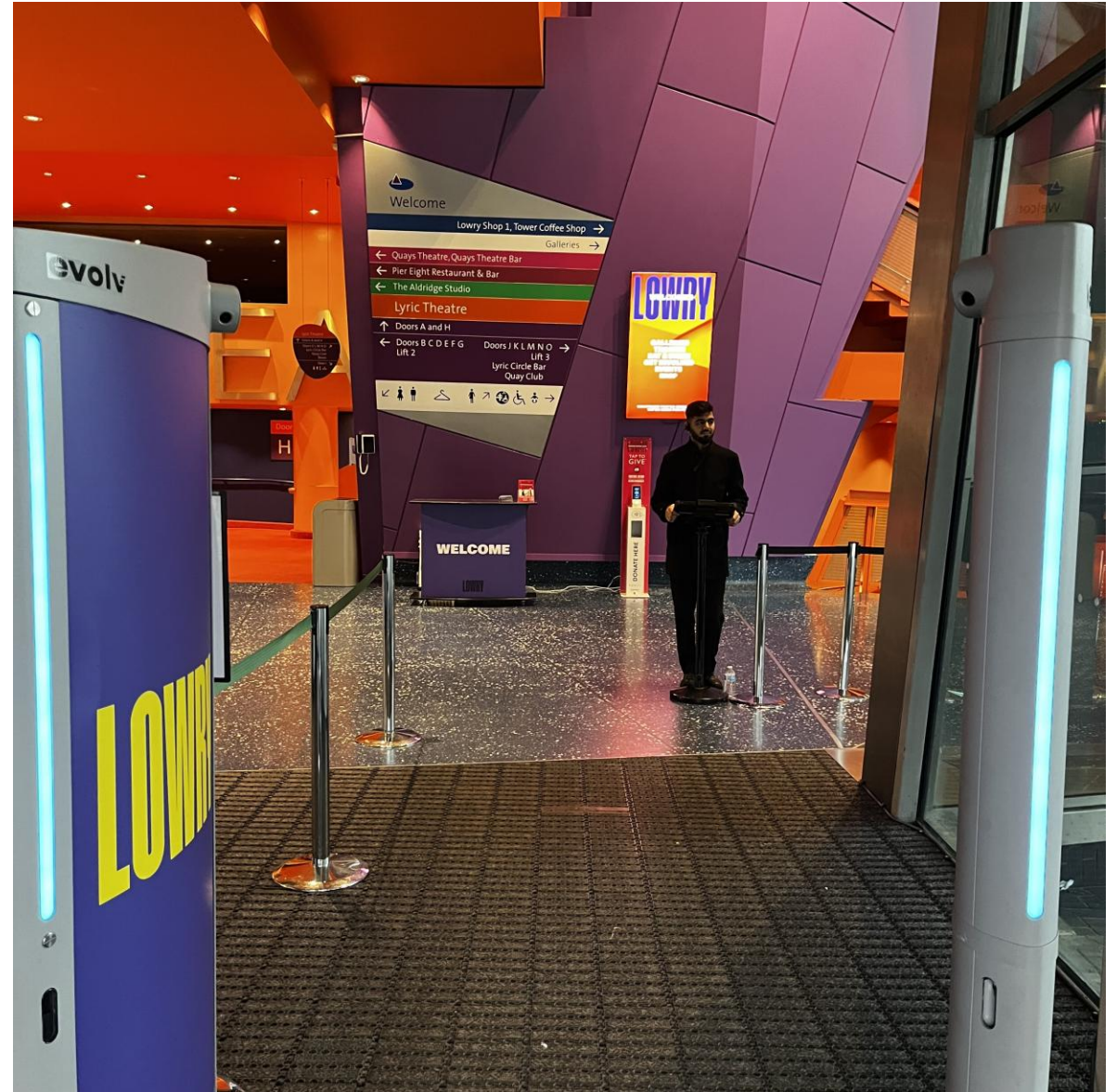
There is textured matt flooring in the entrance to Lowry building and the doors are automatic when activated by a push-button.



When you arrive

You will enter the building through the right set of doors. There will be friendly members of the Security Team to greet you.

You may be asked to open your bag so it can be checked, but don't worry, the team are doing this to help keep visitors safe.



Welcome Desk

The Front of House team are at the Welcome Desk during opening hours to welcome you and offer assistance, they can help you find your way around the building.

Inside the building it is very colourful with orange, yellow, red and purple surfaces. The floor is reflective, hard and slightly sloped.



Quays Theatre

The welcoming and friendly Front of House team are here to help. They will be wearing red or purple tops as seen in the image.

There will be other people there watching shows, but we will turn left at the Welcome Desk, past the people eating at the Restaurant, and round the side of the building to our theatre which is called THE QUAYS THEATRE.



Toilets

There are accessible toilets on both Stalls and 2nd Tier levels.



What will happen?

Lights will remain on low throughout

Re-admittance – ability to come and go

Audience – vocal expressions are welcome

No strobe lighting

What will happen?



In addition:

There has been reduced capacity of seats put on sale so as not to pack the auditorium

There will be drop in relaxed artist led activity in the foyer pre-show, during and post-show.

There will be a TV relay with soft seating available outside of the auditorium

Chill out area in the bar with books and comfortable seating for children to have a quiet moment during the performance.

After the performance



If you wish to visit the toilet, do note that it will be busy, and you might have to wait your turn.

There may also be a bit of a queue as you exit from the main entrance.
